Monideep Dey, PhD is the principal consultant of [Deytec, Inc. USA](#) providing consulting services on public policy, regulation and standardization matters (including conformity assessment) to developing countries pursuing economic development through trade and competitiveness.

Deytec, Inc. is a company member of the [American National Standards Institute](#) (ANSI) and the [International Conformity Assessment Committee \(ICAC\)](#) which is the U.S. interface to the ISO Council Committee on Conformity Assessment ([ISO CASCO](#)). Dr. Dey served as Chairman (Convenor) of ISO TC 92 SC 4 WG 7 from 2013 to 2017 and is an expert in the ISO system of international standards and conformity assessment methods.

Following extensive experience in the development and implementation of national public policy, regulation and standards, Dr. Dey now uses this vast experience to focus his consultancy activities through ANSI and ISO to support development of a National Quality Infrastructure (NQI) in developing economies. Credible conformity assessment services is an essential part of the quality infrastructure of developing economies. The development of a NQI is critical to the sustainable economic development, poverty elimination, and eventual prosperity of developing countries.

During his term as Chairman (Convenor) ISO TC 92 SC 4 WG 7, Monideep Dey proposed and undertook many initiatives in the subcommittee to improve its standards, specifically to make them more suitable for conformity assessment activities. He also undertook many initiatives to become knowledgeable of ISO's strategic mission, standards development system, and ISO's specific role in conformity assessment activities.

Specific initiatives included attendance at the ANSI-hosted ISO Chairs and Convenors workshop and training in Miami, FL in February 2015; the ISO-IEC conference and training on "[Using and referencing ISO and IEC standards to support public policy](#)" and the WTO TBT 20th Anniversary Conference in Geneva both held in November 2015; and most recently the ISO DEVCO meeting and 40th ISO General Assembly in Berlin, September, 2017. Participation at these training, workshops and symposia, supplemented with research on the topics covered has provided Dr. Dey a thorough knowledge of international standardization and conformity assessment, trade and competitiveness, and the components of a national quality infrastructure.

Dr. Dey is now active in ICAC and CASCO activities and in frequent contact with the Directors Sean MacCurtain at CASCO and Lane Hallenbeck at ANSI-ICAC, specifically on work to assist developing countries establish a NQI. He has worked for technical institutes that support the standardization activities of SAC in China, and now participates in the [ANSI-Standards Alliance program](#), most recently for work in Zambia.
